Date	Title	Summary
Jan 8	The Lincoln Lawyer (2011) Rated R for some violence, sexual content and language. Run time 119 min	L.A.'s top criminal defense lawyer, becomes stuck in a deadly game of vengeance and deception that threatens both his career and his life. Starring Matthew McConaughey.
Jan 22	The Help (2011) Rated PG-13 for thematic material. Run time: 146 min.	Set at the start of the Civil Rights movement, a southern society girl decides to write a book from the point of view of the black women who are the domestic help. Once the project begins friendships are ripped apart even as new, unlikely alliances are formed.
Feb 12	Midnight In Paris (2011) Rated PG-13 for sexual references and smoking. Run time: 94 min.	Directed by Woody Allen. A hack writer (Owen Wilson) meets his spoiled fiance in Paris for a holiday and somehow finds himself transported in time to the 1920s where he rubs elbows with famous writers and artists and falls in love with a girl who exists only in the past. A charming film!
Feb 26	The Debt (2011) Rated R for some violence and language. Run time: 113 min.	An espionage thriller. Retired Mossad agents (Helen Mirren and Tom Wilkinson) have been venerated for decades by their country because of a past mission but shocking news and a colleague's death cast doubt on their accomplishment.
Mar 11	Mozart's Sister (2011) Unrated but probably PG-13 equivalent Run time: 120 min. <i>French with English subtitles.</i>	Follows the Mozart family's exhausting life on the road. Nannerl, Wolfgang's older sister, is a talented singer, and musician but she is being sidelined by Wolfgang's growing fame. No longer a precocious tot, Nannerl struggles with her desire to be recognized, her sense of obedience, and the challenges of coming-of-age.
Mar 25	Water For Elephants (2011) Rated PG-13 for moments of intense violence and sexual content. Run time: 120 min.	A homeless, penniless veterinary student (Robert Pattinson) joins a traveling circus full of drunks, forlorn animals, including a beautiful elephant and a vicious, unstable ring master. He soon falls in love with the ring master's wife (Reese Witherspoon). Old school Hollywood action/romance.
Apr 1	My Afternoons With Margueritte (2010) Unrated PG-13 equivalent <i>French with English subtitles</i> Run time: 82 min.	A seemingly simple-minded "village idiot" (Gerard Depardieu) befriends 96 year-old Margueritte (Gisele Casadesus). She's brilliant and frail, He's nearly illiterate but the afternoons they spend together transform both their lives.
Apr 15	The Conspirator (2011) Rated PG-13 Some violent content Run time: 122 min.	Based on true events. 7 men and 1 woman, Mary Surrat, are arrested for conspiracy in the assassination of Abraham Lincoln. As the nation turns against her, Mary must rely on her war-hero attorney to uncover the truth and save her life.
